BISHOP MATTHEW CLARK HAS A MESSAGE FOR US, by Edwin Metzger, Father Ted.

Actually, our Bishop has written a book called "FORWARD IN HOPE" (*), and it's not just for us. It is for anyone who wants to read it. It is addressed to you lay people who are reading this bulletin, and to us clergy, too, who work with the laity through a kind of 'give and take' ministry.

In his introduction, he says "The growth in numbers of lay ecclesial ministers in the United States has been astounding, with more than 30,000 working in a wide variety of pastoral settings". (Editor's note: 'ecclesial' is a Latinized word for 'church' and lay church ministers are working in parishes, diocesan offices, hospitals, prisons - - and that is only a partial list.)

Our own parishes of Holy Name and Mercy have been served well by lay church ministers from the parishes' foundation. I'll mention two current staff members only because they have recently written STAFF TIME / STAFF CORNER articles. Other staff members are listed in the *Pastoral Staff* boxes in both bulletins. Marie Marton and Peggy Malvaso both have finished courses at St Bernard's School of Theology and Ministry right here in Rochester, near the Nazareth College campus. Marie has a Master's

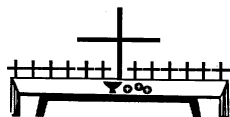
Degree in Pastoral Ministry, and Peggy a Certificate in Pastoral Ministry. In the Jan 3, 2010 bulletin, Marie urges us to use individually or in a small group, DVDs on: The Sacraments of Healing, The Gospel of John, Scripture in Daily Life, The Virtue of Chastity, and Sports and Spirituality. In last week's bulletin (Jan 10), Peggy gives encouragement to overcome 'the winter blahs' by spiritual exercises.

Pardon this personal note, but as I glide effortlessly past my 80th birthday, I feel I need religion and spirituality more than ever. Of course I look to the clergy of our parish, Father Gagnier and Deacons Placious and Lombard. But I also look to the lay ecclesial ministers of our diocese. As Bishop Clark says as he concludes the introduction, "We simply could not do without lay ecclesial ministers. The ideas, energy and creativity they have and continue to offer simply cannot be replaced".

Jr. High & Sr. High Youth

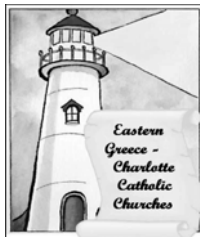
Dan Anderson, Youth Group Leader encourages all youth to attend their respective group meetings as we start a new year. The schedule is as follows:
