We had a successful pilgrimage to Rome last week. There were two conferences at the Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls, the burial site of St. Paul. We also visited the other three Holy Year basilicas, St. Mary Major and St. John Lateran and, St. Peter at Vatican City. There was also a day trip to Assisi. All states except NJ were represented and Mexico, Phillipines and Poland

I had the rare opportunity to speak at length with the current Supreme Knight, **Carl Anderson** who has served at the K of C office in new New Haven, CT for ten years. I also met with **Virgil Dechant**. He is past Supreme Knight who served for 24 years and is now retired in his native state of Kansas.

As you know, we are planning a replacement this summer of the air conditioning and heating of the Parish Center. I expect to get a letter out to you soon about this and our annual Insurance bill.

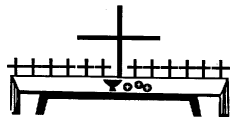
