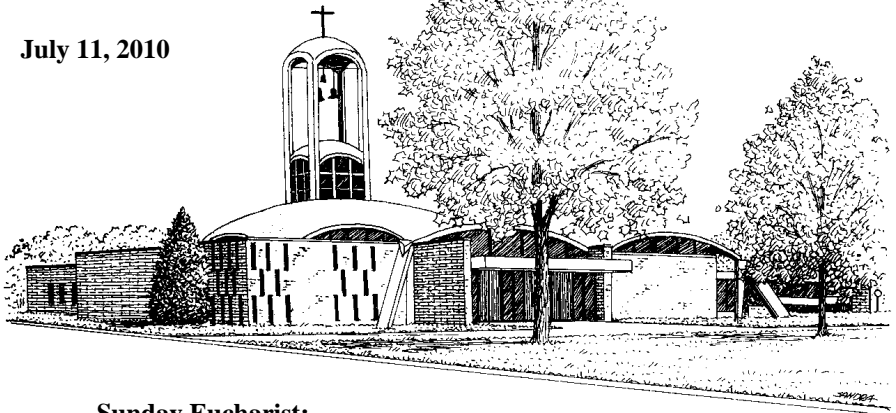

Staff Time by Fr. Gagnier

Dear Parishioners,

In just a few weeks, we will come to the 46th anniversary of the incorporation of our parish in 1964.

We will have our regional banner in church through the weekend of July 31-August 1. Also in celebration of our anniversary, the Parish Picnic will be held on Sunday August 1 after the 11 AM Mass.

By now you have received our letter about the annual insurance bill and the forthcoming project to replace the air conditioning and heating of the Parish Center.

Unfortunately a contractor bidding error was not brought to our attention until after the letters were done. The bid was for three units, a 10 ton unit and two 5 ton units. It should have been two 10 ton units and one 5 ton. The two 10 ton units are for the Parish Center and the 5 ton is for the Daily Mass Chapel between the church and the Parish Center.



With a study of the ductwork and engineering, it was found that we can cool the Parish Center with two 7.5 ton units rather than two 10 ton units. This will save energy in the long run. However, the extra size will cost **\$1,500** more, which increases the price to **\$21,893**. I thank you for your generosity in this special envelope which will pay for the heating and air conditioning project as well as our insurance.

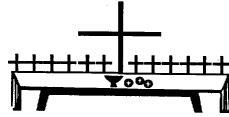

Next week, we will welcome a visiting priest as part of the Missionary Co-op Program. Our visitor will be **Father Paul Henry Fosu** of the Diocese of Kumasi in Ghana, West Africa. I appreciate your generosity to the larger church as we strive to make the Holy Name of Jesus known throughout the world.

I will be attending the annual Preaching Institute at St. Bernard's this Tuesday. Mass will be at 8:00 AM.

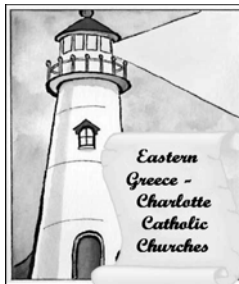
Visiting Missionary Next Week

As part of the Mission Cooperation Plan, Fr. Peter Henry Fosu, a diocesan priest, comes to us as a representative of the Archdiocese of Kumasi, Ghana. The Archdiocese was established in 1950 by missionaries. Since 1970, it has been divided into five dioceses and became an Province in 2003. This phenomenal growth is also an indication of the intensity of work that goes with it. The Archdiocese of Kumasi has a population of about 605,000 inhabitants, with about half of their number living in rural areas. We have 34 parishes, with 158 mission stations. There are 70 priests, 66 Religious Sisters and Brothers, and nearly 400 Catechists serving the poor under harsh conditions

The Archdiocese of Kumasi needs your assistance in building schools. Our growth has required construction of a new Christ the Teacher Training College, St. Gregory the Great Major Seminary, as well as a Girl's Hostel at the Nkrumah University of Science and Technology.

Without your help we cannot continue to manage our increase in vocations. Furthermore, we cannot provide clean water and build clinics for the advancement of the Church's healing ministry and the care of the poor and underprivileged. Your contribution is much appreciated.
