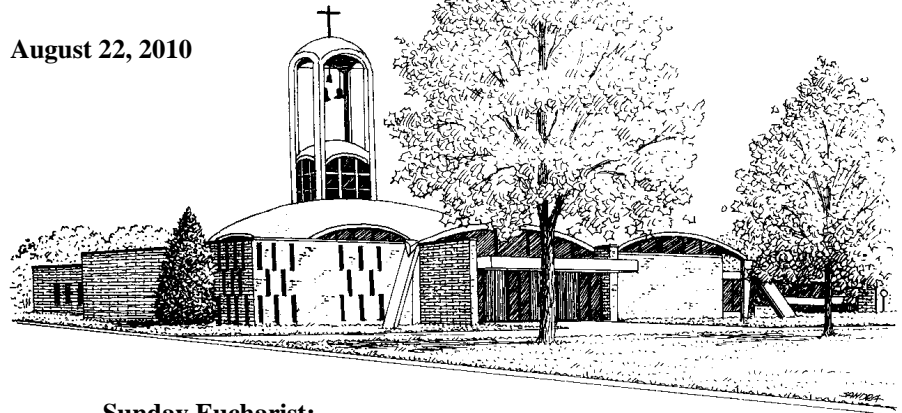

## Staff Time

from Deacon Dick

I am beginning to get squared away. I am sharing an office in the rectory with Fr. Metzger. At the rate I am going I figure I will be fully moved in say, just about 2011. My telephone extension is 621-4040 ext. 25. However, the best way to reach me is on my cell phone, 259-3846. For the time being, I am officially assigned to the parish for 10-12 hours per week, mostly on weekends. As of October 1, I will be at the parish several additional days per week. The reality is that I find myself involved four or five days per week regardless of what the official agreement says. Some of that time is devoted to the disposition of the property at Our Lady of Mercy parish.

Several people have asked me if Rose Marie will be joining the parish. Rose Marie has her own ministry at Holy Apostles parish where she runs the Urban Outreach program. When she began this ministry seven years ago, she thought it would be best if she joined the parish.

Some have also wondered how a small parish like ours was able to have two deacons, in view of the great demand for deacons in parishes and other institutions. Part of the answer is that Fr. Gagnier was given the responsibility for the disposition of the property of Our Lady of Mercy parish. It was thought that because of my familiarity with OLM I could take on much of that work and free him for his work here at Holy Name of Jesus. Another part of the answer is that I lobbied shamelessly for this assignment. I called everyone I know in positions of authority and I called in every favor owed to me. I should add

that it is my great pleasure to work with Deacon Joe. He is very easy to get along with, his passion is his service to the people and with Deacon Joe, what you see is what you get. Deacon assignments are for three years, with the possibility of renewal for up to 12 years. In my official appointment to the parish, it states that the bishop reserves the right to move me at any time if a great need occurs somewhere else. I don't think that will happen but if it should, I would go where the bishop sends me.

In addition to my ministry at the parish I have a funeral ministry in which I do around 100 funerals a year for people who have no connection with a church and, with Rose Marie, run Isaiah Ministries, a national parish mission ministry.

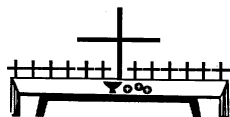
I am eagerly looking forward to working with and for you. I am sure that God has great things planned for us!
