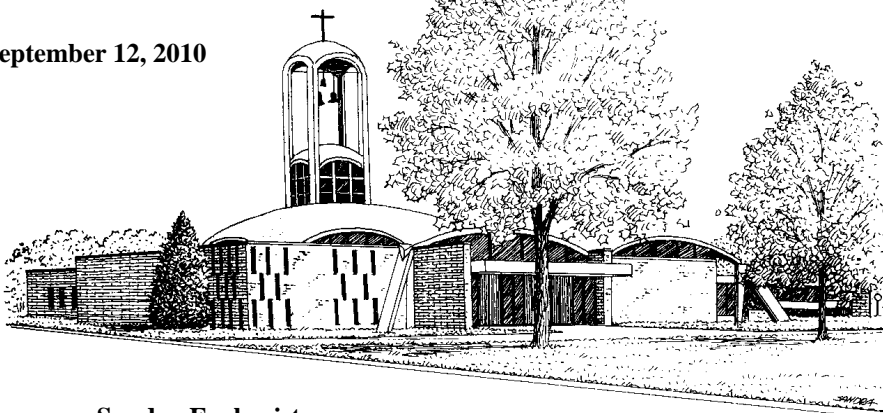

I would like to mention the fact that we now have special devotions each First Friday at 7:00 P.M.

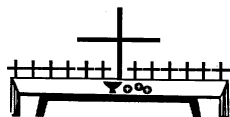
This consists of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy and readings from the Diary of Saint Faustina Kowalska, (1905-1938.) In 1931, Jesus appeared to her and asked that an image be painted with the "signature" "Jesus, I trust in you."

In addition, she was given the prayer called the Chaplet and to publicize it throughout the world. As so often happens, it would not be until years after her death that her revelations were taken seriously and approved by the authorities of the church.

During the time of Karol Cardinal Wojtyla as the Archbishop of Krakow, a new investigation of her writings took place. Later, this same cardinal became Pope John Paul II and had the occasion to canonize Sister Faustina the first saint Jubilee year 2000.

Deacon James Witulski, a resident of Greece who serves at St. Stanislaus Church, invites you any First Friday at 7 PM to hear the revelations of Saint Faustina and pray the chaplet in the presence of the exposed Blessed Sacrament. Our prayer is that Holy Name of Jesus will continue to prosper and grow in our knowledge of the Mercy of God. **Fr. Gagnier**

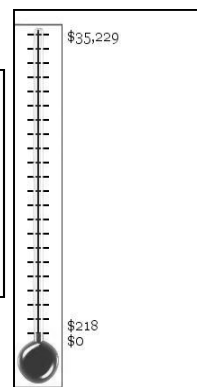

Parent/Guardian Information Meetings

If your child is already registered or should be attending faith formation (Grades K-12) this coming year and/or if your child plans to prepare to receive a Sacrament this coming year, then you are expected to attend one of two parent information meetings scheduled for Saturday, September 18th. You need attend only ONE meeting. One will be held at St. John the Evangelist Parish Center at 10AM and the other will be held at 1PM at Holy Name of Jesus Parish Center.

Opening of Faith Formation

Faith Formation for children in Grades K-5 will begin on September 26th. The first Sunday class will be at 9:30AM September 26th and the first Monday class will be 6:30PM on September 27. Both programs will take place in the Parish Center at Holy Name of Jesus. If you have not yet registered, please do so as soon as possible. First Penance Registration

Register now if your child is planning on receiving his or her First Penance. These forms are also available on your parish web site. The first workshop is scheduled for Saturday, October 2 at 10AM in Holy Name of Jesus Parish Center. This is **mandatory** for all parents/guardians of children who intend to register for and prepare for the Sacrament. Remember, if your child/youth intends to register for and receive the Sacrament of First Eucharist or Confirmation, they must first be prepared for First Penance.

Food for the Poor Speaker

Next weekend, September 18 & 19 we will welcome Father Larry Bower, begging for spiritual and financial assistance on behalf of Food for the Poor. Father Larry served in the U. S. Navy for several years before being ordained to the priesthood for the Diocese of Baker, Oregon~~the second largest (area-wise), and one of the poorest, dioceses within the United States. While with the Baker Diocese, Father Larry spent several years working on an Indian reservation, and then with Hispanic migrant workers. He is now living in a suburb of Charles, South Carolina, in a home he bought while serving as a Supply Corps office on board a nuclear submarine, back in the late 1970’s. God has gifted Father Larry with a real appreciation of what the generosity of people can do to help the very poorest of God’s poor. This has led him to full-time ministry with Food for the Poor, the largest international relief and development organization in the nation. With more than 97% of all donations going directly to programs that help those in need, Food For The Poor provides nourishing food, safe shelter, necessary medical care, educational materials, support for orphans and the aged, and much more to the poorest of the poor in 17 countries in the Caribbean and Central America.
