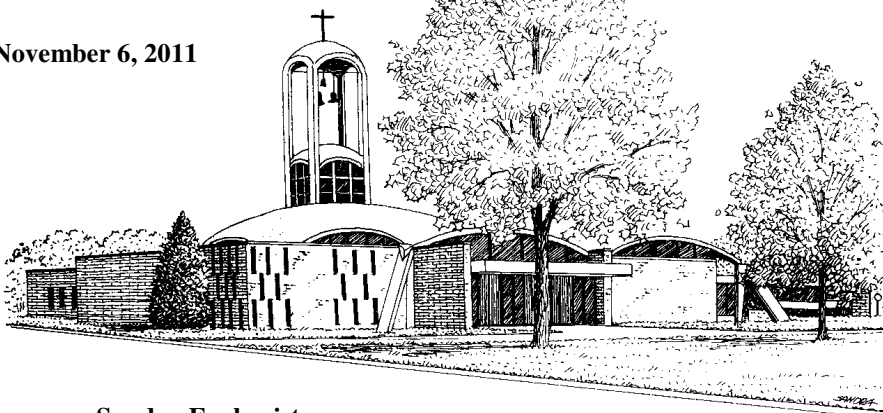

**In Memory of Dominic Fragnito
December 13, 1894 — February 22, 1988
Veteran, World War I Private, U.S. Army**

Next Sunday before the 11:00 AM Mass, we will raise the service flag of **Dominic Fragnito**, veteran of the First World War who served in the United States Army in France from May 1918 to April 1919. He saw action in the St. Mihiel Offensive, September 12-16, 1918 and the Meuse-Argonne Offensive from September 26 until the war ended on Armistice Day, at the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month: 11 November 1918. This date remained a holiday for years, continuing to be known as *Armistice Day*.

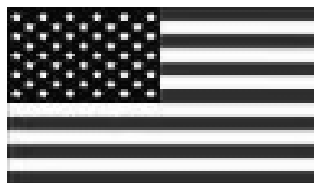
Since 1954, this day is known as *Veteran's Day* when we honor the living veterans among us as the 34th President, Dwight David Eisenhower, himself a General in World War II, signed this proclamation:

"I have today signed a proclamation calling upon all of our citizens to observe Thursday, November 11, 1954 as Veterans Day. It is my earnest hope that all veterans, their organizations, and the entire citizenry will join hands to insure proper and widespread observance of this day.

I have every confidence that our Nation will respond wholeheartedly in appropriate observance of Veterans Day, 1954."

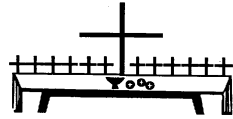
After his service to our nation, Dominic became a citizen on December 19, 1919. By voting in an Italian election in 1946, Dominic briefly lost his American citizenship but again took an oath of allegiance at the U.S. Consulate General at Naples, Italy in 1953.

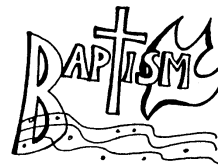

A Note on the Financial Report

Some parishioners asked why our income was lower in the first quarter than last year. Our full insurance bill was paid July 1. Insurance Collection and Raffle were held in May, not in the summer as previously. This put that income in the previous fiscal year while the bill was in the current fiscal year. This way, we again paid our insurance on time with a 1% discount.

In more recent news, we have just signed a contract for **snow removal for the coming season: \$6,210.00**. The bill for this usually comes in April. Thank you all for your generosity throughout the year.
